



## Peter J. Hlookoff 1925 - 2012

Peter was born November, 3, 1925 to John and Nellie Hlookoff in Grand Forks, BC. Peter was the eldest of four children – Fred, John and Helen.

Peter attended the Fructova School for a short time and then helped on the family farm. The family lived on top of Spencer Hill that became known as the Hlookoff Village. Peter's mother past away suddenly when the children were young. Later, when Peter's father remarried he gained a step sister and later a half brother Harry, and two half sisters – Alice and Victoria.

As a young teen Peter enjoyed playing his guitar and singing with his brothers and, like many young people in the area, he went to work in the Okanagan orchards.
